Introduction



The MSc in Crowded Space Design, Management and Risk Analysis is the culmination of forty years work in the crowded space environment using the knowledge and experience of a wide range of practitioners and academics to explore this captivating area.

This Masters degree has an interdisciplinary approach and is specifically work-based. Taught through the ‘Learning in the Round’ philosophy, the facilitators (tutors), experts and participants (who are also experts in specific areas) are interchangeable and therefore provide a foundational platform for the creation of new knowledge, which can be challenged and practiced in the safe environments of the classroom, the workshop and ultimately the participants own work space.

The programme wrestles with the fundamental concepts of urban and non-urban planning, the five dimensions of space and time, and questions the underlying beliefs of the management of crowded space.

By examining how the crowded space is evolving and the way in which we can utilise these changes to deliver solutions, this qualification can provide tools which can help to enhance the crowds experience, thus reducing the risk and challenges of both the dynamics of the crowd and their associated behaviours.

On successful completion of the programme, participants will receive the requisite academic recognition associated with this level of learning.
